Humanitarian Outreach Programmes

Through the generous support of devotees and well-wishers, the Ashram supports many indigent families. Grocery hampers and other essentials are donated via local schools in the greater Durban area; the Happy Hours Home for the Mentally Challenged; Kerr House for Women; Phoenix Community Hospice; Inzenzo Health Care Centre; Sherwood Hospice; Kennedy Road Informal Settlement and to many indigent families.

The following assistance is proffered:

- During the school semester, bread, jam and peanut butter are donated twice a week to Collegevale Primary School.
- Blankets, warm pyjamas and T-shirts are donated to indigent families.
- Fresh vegetables, milk, bread, jam and cereals are donated to families each week.
- Over a hundred patients are fed each week at the Inzenzo Health Care Centre.
- Grocery hampers are distributed to schools, Homes and indigent families, each month.
- A monthly contribution is made to the Durban Council for S.A. Women.
- 400 Diwali hampers are donated to schools; Old Age Homes and Children's Homes.
- A meal is provided to the students at the Nagari Pracharini School annually.
- Stationery, uniforms, shoes and school bags are donated to needy school pupils.
- Bursaries were awarded to students for tertiary education.
- Soccer jerseys and other clothing were donated to schools; Children's Homes and indigent families.
- Occupational Therapy is offered to patients weekly.
